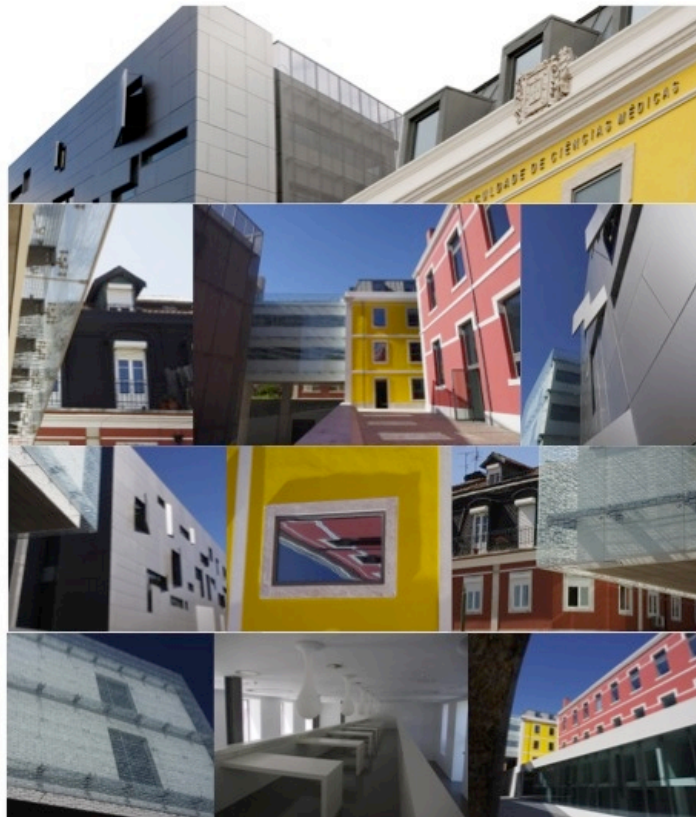

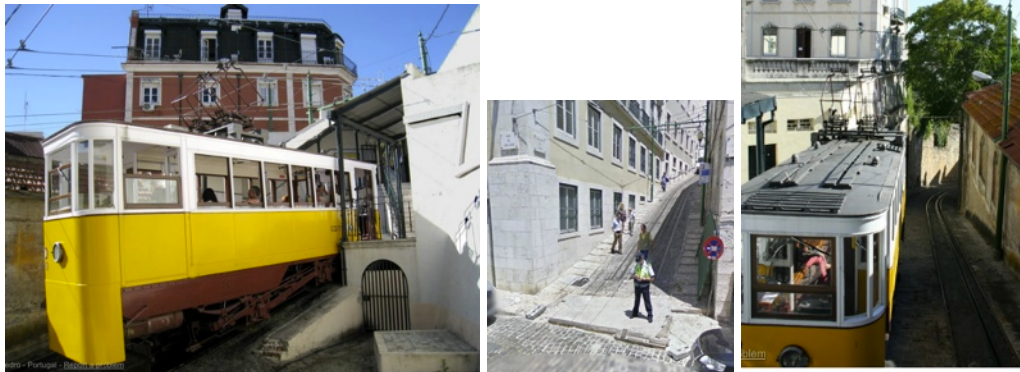

How to reach CEDOC from most of the hotels:

Lisbon is said to have seven-hills and our meeting site (CEDOC) is on the top of one of them! So, from most of the hotels you need to go uphill. For this, different biological and mechanical options are available:

1) “Elevador do Lavra” which is a sort of elevator (funicular) or better describing a “tram with high heels”: 120 years old and already a National Monument.



2) Walking up the hill through [Calçada do Lavra](#)

3) Walking up the hill through [Jardim do Torel](#), a garden coming from Rua São José. This is a longer walking distance but with a great view to Lisbon.

4) If you use a taxi to get to CEDOC, or if you are walking/driving with your map/GPS you should use the following address: Rua Câmara Pestana nº 6, 6-A.
